SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The applicant agrees to the following conditions covering the construction work:

The Applicant shall assume all liability for, and save the Township, its agents and employees harmless from any and all claims for damages, action or causes of action arising out of the work to be done under this request, whether by Applicant or its contractor or subcontractors.

Said work shall be completed in conformity with all applicable laws, regulations, and codes covering said work. All work shall be in conformity with regulations of governmental agencies for the protection of the public.

Wherever top soil and sod are disturbed, it shall be replaced and maintained until the turf is established.

The said work shall not interfere with any existing utility facilities on the Township right-of-way.

Appropriate barricades, warning devices, and flag-person, shall be provided by the Applicant during all phases of their construction and maintenance operations on Township right-of-way.

Upon completion of work, the Applicant shall restore the Township right-of-way to its original or satisfactory condition. The Applicant shall then notify the Township of the completion of the work so that inspection can be made to determine its acceptability.

Damage resulting from the work described shall be paid for in its entirety by the Applicant.

At least 24 hour notice to the Township shall be given before work shall take place.

Applicant is responsible for contacting Gopher State One Call for utility locates before they begin work.
