BELLEVUE TOWNSHIP ROAD POLICY

The Road Acceptance Criteria dated 10-20-95 was amended at the November 5, 2003, regular meeting of the township to read as follows: (Motion: Ken Block, Second: Don Rudolph)

All roads hereafter accepted by Bellevue Township must meet the following minimum criteria:

- A. All roads hereafter accepted must comply with the Township minimum construction/maintenance standards.
- B. Subdivision road width dedications must be no less than 66 feet.
- C. All plat road dedications must provide easement connection with existing public roads of sufficient end-point cul-de-sac turn around easement.
- D. All roads accepted shall have 66 feet minimum easement width and a 2 inch compressed blacktopped <u>Driving Surface</u> of no less than 20 feet, and no more than 24 feet wide, over a 7 inch Class 5 base, with preference given to the town's maintenance equipment capabilities.
- E. New construction <u>Ditch Area Inslope</u> shall have a 4:1 ratio over inslope length.
- F. Previous specifications and criteria as to road construction must be complied with except as noted above.
